Overview: A limited number of assistantships are available annually in all graduate programs and can be awarded to students who are fully admitted, degree-seeking students. Individual offices on campus also offer assistantship positions.

Requirements: Students awarded an assistantship are required to be enrolled in graduate courses and must maintain a satisfactory grade point average of at least a 3.0 at the Graduate School. Out-of-state students with assistantships may apply for an abatement, qualifying them for funds to cover the difference between in-state and out-of-state tuition rates.
